

RACING RULES '10

General Rules

1. Absolutely NO PIT RIDING on race days!
1st violation- Disqualification
2nd violation- 30 day suspension (practices and races at all E-Street MX tracks)
3rd violation- Mandatory 1 year suspension
2. Bad Sportsmanship- from anyone attending an event will not be tolerated. (Fighting is considered bad sportsmanship.)
3. Transponders are mandatory to race. It is the riders' responsibility to rent or buy a transponder before signing up to race. It is the Riders' responsibility to properly charge and place the transponder on their bike.
4. Golf Carts/ Rhinos must be operated by persons 18 yrs of age or older.
5. Take tires & Trash with you. Do NOT leave any used oil in trash cans. Please take with you.
Trash- Pack it in, Pack it out. Violators will not be welcome at E-Street MX events.
6. Parking should be orderly and space efficient. NO Blocking off space around your truck/trailer.
7. All pets must be on a leash.
8. Reprimanding or yelling at other people's children will NOT be tolerated. Please come to sign ups for assistance with problematic situations.
9. No spectators beyond spectator areas. Do NOT enter track.
10. We reserve the right to change or add rules at any time without reprinting.

Racing Rules

1. Racers in wrong practice sessions will be disqualified.

2. 1st lap of every race day practice is sight lap. NO jumping on sight lap or disqualification.
3. Riders racing without caution by downed rider and/or event staff, medical staff will be disqualified.
4. Racers must exit track upon checkered flag.
5. Pro Racers paid per moto. All other classes per overall.
6. Racers must reenter track at first safe opportunity to do so without taking advantage.
7. Racers disregarding caution flags will be disqualified.
8. Flags-
 - Green- Start
 - Red- Restart
 - Black- Disqualified (Personal)
 - Red Cross- Medical (Absolutely NO jumping that obstacle)
 - White- Last Lap (Courtesy Flag, not required)
 - Checkered Flag- Finish
9. PROTESTS- \$100 FILING FEE, FEE GOES TO WINNER OF PROTEST. EVENT REFEREE'S DECISION IS FINAL.
10. Mandatory Riders meeting between race practice and 1st moto. Failure to attend results in disqualification.

All 65cc classes-

11yrs* and under

Equipment- Modified bikes ok

All 85cc classes-

16yrs* and under

150cc 4strokes ok

85cc Beginner class-

Big Wheel ok

SuperMini class-

Open ability and Open Machinery

Big Wheels ok

85cc Open-

Open ability, not open machinery (No Big Bores, but Big
Wheels ok)

250cc classes-

250cc four strokes and 125cc two strokes only

Schoolboy class-;

16yrs* and under

450cc classes-

450cc four strokes and 250 two strokes only

+25,+30,+40 classes

All size Big Bikes ok

Ages correspond to age when series began

All + classes except Pro may race one division lower in

250cc/450cc classes

Womens classes-

Female riders only

85cc and up

125cc 2-stroke only classes-

Two Stroke only, up to 144cc

OPEN big bike classes-

All size big bikes

OPEN UNLIMITED class-

Open ability and open machinery

*Riders age is based on age as of round #1 of Current Series.
